1. Job Position A Project Associate Professor for Cooperation Program on Synchrotron Radiation Science, which will be launched April 2025 at Graduate School of Frontier Science, the University of Tokyo

2. Work Duties Successful applicant will conduct research and supervise students' research on cutting-edge x-ray optics and synchrotron-radiation science by utilizing a large synchrotron radiation facility SPring-8 and x-ray free-electron laser SACLA in cooperation with RIKEN SPring-8 Center.
